

Three Point Shootout

The three point shootout is a shooting contest behind the 3-point line from 5 stations as diagramed below. It is a team activity. Each school will select two players to shoot. The other players will rebound and restack the ball racks. After all teams have shot, the top two teams will advance to the final round. The team with the most points in the final round will be declared the Team Champions. The player with the most 3-point baskets in the final round will be declared the Individual Champion.

Three Point Shootout Rules:

1 minute and 15 seconds (75 seconds) time limit

Five balls at each station (A,B,C,D,E). Each of the first four balls are worth 1 point, while the last ball at each station is worth 2 points.

Shooters must start from behind the three point line! If the shooter's foot touches or goes over the line before the release, the shot will not be counted.

Each shooter will have a 45 second warm up period.
