To bring up to Athletic Directors:

1. Dan, MD coach, was concerned that a game had to be forfeited and two teams did not play on Friday. All teams would have been able to play.
2. Please tell your coaches that at least one Coach, not parent or other representative, is required to be at all games. When a coach is not present at a game it is a big disadvantage for those teams players in the All Tournament team ballot.
3. We would like to change the rules of our Hot Shot Competition. When we have 6 teams or less we will have the competition for the top two players from each team AT the tournament. If there are more than 6 teams involved in the tournament we want to change the rules and have the teams compete at home and bring their top two players. This will save time and with the expanded number of teams, we will then be able to complete all competitions.
4. With 8 teams in the tournament we want to also increase the number of All Tournament Team awards to a total of 14. This way every team can have a representative and we can still have the best players in the tournament on the team.
