

Team Foul Shooting

Pairings for teams shooting will be determined by drawing names from a hat. A coin flip will determine choice of baskets. Each team will be given a three minute warm up period. Teams will be given ten minutes in which to sink as many foul shots as possible. The players will line up along the key to rebound for the shooter (see diagram). In the first round, the shooter must shoot until she hits. Then she moves on after her next miss. If a player misses ten consecutive attempts, then she may move on. * If a player steps over the line while shooting, it constitutes a miss.

The number of girls required to shoot in the first round is determined by the number of girls on the team with the fewest players. After the first round, a player must move on if she misses a shot. A record will be kept of each team's score. Each shot is worth one point. The two teams with the highest totals will compete in a playoff for the championship. The score will begin again at zero. A coin flip will again determine choice of baskets.

A team trophy will be presented to the championship team.
