



## ESDAA VOLLEYBALL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- When:** generally the first weekend in November
- Entry Fee:** \$100 per school. Host school will receive a check from ESDAA Treasurer
- Participants Permitted:** 12 players, 1 manager, 2 coaches, 1 driver = 16
- Rule Book:** NCAA or FEDERATION  
Host school decides
- Awards:** Team trophy for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and sportsmanship  
individuals for 1<sup>st</sup> place (15)  
individual awards for all-stars  
if 5 or less teams – 10 awards  
if 6 or more teams – 12 awards  
order 2 extra in case of ties or special situations\*
- All Stars:** All schools must be represented on the all – Tournament team. If after the voting a team is not represented, the top vote getter from that team will be **ADDED**.  
\*She will not take the place of a girl who was voted to the team.
- At the conclusion of the first night or round robin each coach nominates players from his/her team to be considered for the all-tournament team.
- coach's vote using a 1-10 ranking system with 10 being the highest
  - coaches may not vote for their own player
  - ballots must be handed in by the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> game of the championship match
- Team sportsmanship should be included on the ballot.
- Format:** Round Robin or Pool Play results determines the seeding for brackets in the elimination rounds. It is generally agreed that teams would like to play as much as possible in the preliminary rounds.
- Number of courts available, number of teams and time constraints will help the host school determine format in the preliminary round.
- If at all possible, 2 games to 25 points (must win by 2) using rally scoring should be played in round robin/pool play.
- If there are 7 or more teams with a round robin format and one court, 1 game to 25 using rally scoring may be used.
- For Round Robin Pool Play a 30-point cap will be in effect.
- At the end of round robin/pool play teams will be bracketed according to there finish in the round robin/pool.
