- b) Round Robin Format - when using two mats/one day
 - 1) 9:30 - 12:00 p.m. Saturday 1st and 2nd rounds
 - 12:00 - 2:00 p.m. Saturday Final Round - 1 mat
 - 2:00 - 2:30 p.m. Saturday Awards
 - 2) Seeding to allow the two best wrestlers to meet in the final round. Criteria in order of importance: returning champion, head to head competition (supersedes first criteria), and best overall record.
 - 3) Scoring
 - a) no advancement points
 - b) classification points to be given according to National Federation Rules Book
 - c) team place points - 14-10-7-4
 - 4) Criteria for ties
 - a) Won/lost record
 - b) Head to head competition
 - c) Classification points
 - d) If still tied, give both players 1st, etc.
- C. Participants per weight class per school - a school may have more than one wrestler in a weight class if there are less than 5 wrestlers in the weight class and that this person be designated at weigh-in time as a non-scoring participant.
